This packet includes important information for the middle school musical, *Finding Nemo JR.*, about auditions, the rehearsal process, and a list of important dates. Please look for the following:

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<u>SYNOPSIS</u>: Based on the beloved animated film of the same name, *Finding Nemo JR*. tells the tale of an adventurous fish named Nemo who finds himself out on his own for the first time ever. As his overprotective father, Marlin, searches frantically for his son, he winds up on a life-changing journey of his own, discovering that the best way to hold onto someone you love is ultimately to let them go, even a little. Nemo, Marlin, Dory, Bruce, Gill, Crush, and many other charismatic creatures fill this bubbly story in this musical stage adaptation.

<u>ABOUT THE PROCESS</u>: Finding Nemo JR. will be an ensemble-based production that rehearses after school from 3:45-5:45pm. Every student who auditions is guaranteed a role in the production.

**All rehearsals and performances will take place in Jack M. Barrack Hebrew Academy's auditorium. The process begins on September 19th with performances December 3-5th.

CHARACTER BREAKDOWN:

All characters will be portrayed by performers in grades 6-8 with gender-flexible casting. We reserve the right to change and update roles throughout the rehearsal process and depending on the number of students who audition.

Marlin - a good clownfish father who wants what's best for his son. Throughout the play, he learns to "go with the flow" and trust in others

Coral - a down-to-earth clownfish who's ready to be a mother, protecting her kids at any cost

Nemo - a clownfish who's full of wonder and awe at this "big blue world," which sometimes lands him in to trouble

Pearl - an excitable octopus student in Nemo's class

Sheldon - an H2O intolerant seahorse student in Nemo's class with an appetite for trouble

Tad - an obnoxious butterflyfish student in Nemo's class

Parents of Pearl, Sheldon, and Ray - Marlin's peers who are experts at the first day of school, trying to put him at ease.

Professor Ray - Nemo's teacher, a wise manta ray who loves his job

Dory - a blue tang with short term memory loss who helps Marlin find Nemo

Bruce - a shark who's finding it hard to stay vegetarian; the leader of the friend group

Chum - a shark in Bruce's program. He's trying his best, but his best isn't that great; the brawns of the friend group

Anchor - a shark in Bruce's program. A loyal and devout vegetarian; the brains of the friend group

Bubbles - a friendly yellow tang who loves bubbles

Bloat - an open-minded and supportive blowfish

Gurgle - a nervous royal gramma fish who values order and cleanliness

Peach - a starfish who offers guidance and reassurance
Gill - the leader of the Tank Gang who will stop at nothing to return to the ocean
Nigel - a friendly pelican who knows all the happenings on the Sydney Pier
Crush - a laid-back, 150-year-old sea turtle
Kai - Crush's friend who's rambunctious and playful
Breeze - Crush's friend who's chill and zen
Squirt - Crush's fearless kid
Scuba Diver Dancer - floats the diver's mask that leads Dory and Marlin to Nemo

Featured Ensemble - includes jellyfish, moonfish, lobsters, octopuses, lobsters, sharks, turtles, and more!

Audition Information

All actors must audition in order to participate in *Finding Nemo JR*. Actors will audition for two Wolf PAC Teaching Artists: a Director/Choreographer and a Music Director. They are excited to get to know Barrack students, and then determine the proper place for each of you!

Audition Details

Auditions will be held in the auditorium on Monday, September 11th from 3:45-5:45pm. You will be asked to stay for the entire two hours.

At the initial audition, each performer will sing individually for the Directors and then will learn a dance together as a full group.

NOTE: Since there is no formal monologue at the initial audition, it is really important that we see **acting choices** in the performance of your song.

Callback Details

Acting & singing callbacks will be held in the auditorium on Tuesday, September 12th from 3:45-6:45pm

If you are needed for a callback, we will notify you via email during the day on **Tuesday, September 12th.** Not every actor will necessarily be needed at callbacks. However, *this does not mean you have not been cast in a production*. It simply means we saw everything we needed to at the first auditions!

Casting and Rehearsal Information

Casting is based on **three main criteria**: talent, commitment, and availability. Once the production staff has had the chance to assess the criteria for every actor who auditions, we will assign roles based on what is the best fit for the actor and the overall production.

Cast lists will be sent out via email no later than Thursday, September 14th.

Audition Material

For your auditions for *Finding Nemo JR.*, choose and prepare one of the vocal selections from the options below. A few noteworthy **hints and helpful ideas**:

- When choosing audition material, pick the one that most excites you and shows off the best of your performance abilities. *All song choices are suited for any gender*. Casting in general will be gender flexible!
- Since there is no monologue to prepare for your initial audition, infusing acting into your song choice is crucial. Decide what the song means, who the character is, etc. and add some personality to the song.
- You may be asked to make some changes/adjustments to your song after you perform it once. It means the Directors are excited to see what *else* you can do since you are already stellar!

Song Options:

All song selections are listed below. In the linked folder, you will find **sheet music** as well as **tracks** to listen to-VOCAL means there is a voice to follow, INSTRUMENTAL means there is just the accompaniment. At your audition, our Music Director will accompany you on piano, so please be sure you are familiar with the music heading into auditions.
