Now all we need is the last piece of the puzzle... you! We can't wait to see you all in a few short months for a summer of joy, community, and theatre magic.







New this summer, we are so excited to offer three unique shows in each two-week session to offer a wide variety of theatrical fun that highlights many genres of musical theatre.

- On day one the campers will sing, read, and dance in our audition process
- At the end of that first day, our directors will sort the campers into one of the three casts
- On the second day, campers will begin rehearsing the specific productions into which they have been placed
- All performances will take place on the second Thursday after the camp day ends

Please note: our productions of all shows are the age-appropriate and family friendly versions of the musicals you know and love! While some of the original productions may feature some humor geared towards adults, these versions have been condensed and edited to keep the spirit of these hilarious shows while cleaning up the material for our campers. For those interested in listening to the recordings before the session, we will make the camper-friendly versions available on our website.





Our one-week sessions offer an exciting opportunity for campers to help craft their own performance for the week.

- Feature a concert-style performance known as a "revue," which means a production consisting of songs from different genres and shows united by some common theme
- Campers will be sorted into one of the four casts before the start of the session (there is no formal audition process due to the nature of the program in a one-week session)
- Campers will work with their Electives counselors to devise interludes that creatively bridge the gap from song to song
- Performances are a unique experience curated by the campers themselves that take place on Friday during the camp day

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#### **ACTIVITIES**

Summer Studio artists will participate in a variety of activities throughout the day. In addition to rehearsals, they will assist in the day-to-day activities and design elements of the younger campers' performances. Artists will also be involved in preparing and leading a dramaturgical workshop for the younger campers based on their group's specific show!

This summer, we are excited to offer a unique project in each session that will culminate in a final presentation (i.e. performance, cabaret, screening, reading, etc.). This program will provide a more diverse artistic experience across various media, including stage, film, voiceover, and more!

#### Acting, Improv, Movement

Get ready to fill up on laughs at the Comedy Buffet! Artists will sample a variety of styles and formats as they chart the development of comedy through the ages, from ancient Greek and Roman comedy to commedia dell'arte to clowning to stand up and sketch comedy. The two-week session will culminate in a showcase of the various comic stylings of the group.



#### Shakespeare, Combat

Back by popular demand, this two-week workshop combines Shakespearean performance with the field of stage combat. Performers will hone both classical language and fight choreography skills in a safe, exciting session based on the most invigorating scenes from Shakespeare's plays like Macbeth, Hamlet, Richard III, and more!



#### Voice, Writing, Film, Editing

In this brand new program, artists will explore the intersections between the thrilling art forms of voiceover and film production. In the first week they will learn the skills and technology behind voiceover acting. In the second week, artists will devise, film, and edit a variety of film trailers for all genres, ranging from horror to period drama to rom-com and beyond!



#### **Musical Theatre**

Artists will create and perform a cabaret of songs from the beloved catalogue of classics that have graced Broadway, including Frozen, Newsies, Beauty and the Beast, and more. A great opportunity to belt out some hits while learning to design and realize an original cabaret performance in a one week session!

#### **HIGHLIGHTS**

cITs will participate in all aspects of the camp day, including leading warm ups, games, and portions of rehearsals. They will have the opportunity to tackle a specific element of the show (direct a scene, stage a song, create and teach choreography) with the guidance of the directors.



#### **MENTORSHIP**

After registration, we will contact CITs to gauge their interests and match them with either CUBS or PAC.

#### **PERFORMANCES**

All CITs will be integral as assistants to the directing team and as Stage Managers to handle the technical aspects of the final performance, including props, lighting, and sound.

#### BECOMING A CIT AT WOLF PAC IS SO REWARDING!

New this year, CITs will receive a personalized recommendation letter from the Camp Director and/or staff upon completion of the program. Plus, a nifty participation certificate that can be used to send off to colleges or confirm volunteer hours for high school programs! In order to receive the letter and certificate, CITs must meet the following criteria:

- ATTENDANCE: CITs must attend at least 80% or more of the camp session (four days per week).
- PARTICIPATION: Each session, the Assistant Camp Director will communicate with the directing teams to confirm that CITs are engaging with the campers and staff in a productive, helpful manner.
- **LEADERSHIP:** Each CIT will direct/teach/choreograph a portion of the show with the guidance of our professional directing teams!

## Electives & Dramaturgy for PAC and Summer Studio







## ELECTIVES

Electives are back this summer at Wolf PAC! Each camp session will feature three Electives Counselors, whose distinct talents and passions will inspire our campers throughout their summer experience. Just like previous years, these talented teaching artists will choose their own exciting courses to offer to the PAC campers. Some highlights in the past include A Cappella Singing, Yoga and Meditation, and even Sock Puppets!

Each session, the three counselors will work with the various groups in these creative workshops, culminating in our Talent Show at the end of each session. These workshops are a great opportunity to expand the campers' artistic horizons beyond the incredible lessons they learn from working together on their fantastic productions throughout the summer. Summer Studio artists will work as teaching assistants for PAC Electives and will then take their own version of each Elective on a rotating basis throughout the session.



Known as the "keepers of the text" and the "cultural conscience," dramaturgs work behind the scenes to ensure the visions of the directors, playwrights, and audiences

all blend together into an exciting and inspiring product. In a new work, the dramaturg challenges and engages with the playwright through the development of the script, as well as represents the intention of the playwright once the script moves into the rehearsal phase. In a revival, the dramaturg educates the cast and creative team on the cultural, historical, and social contexts of the production to create the most authentic world possible on the stage!

This summer at Wolf PAC, our brilliant Summer Studio artists will take on the role of Dramaturg in addition to their session-specific performance. Working together to research and examine the PAC shows, Summer Studio will create a multifaceted workshop for their younger counterparts, including activities, trivia, and even a show-inspired playlist!

The shows featured this summer span a wide range of musical theatre style and history, ranging from Golden Age classics all the way to pop and rock hits. Over the course of each session, our Summer Studio Dramaturgs will help guide their younger counterparts through this musical rollercoaster. Campers might learn facts about the Russian Revolution that looms not too distant in Fiddler on the Roof or explore the T.S. Eliot poems that inspired the musical Cats. They will learn the tales of King Arthur that get the silliest send-up in Spamalot and the origins of the jukebox musical, an exciting genre that has turned so many classic bands into great shows like Rock of Ages. And of course, the summer would not be complete without a nod to the pop culture phenomenon of Legally Blonde, allowing campers to explore how a film is adapted into a stage musical. These thrilling sessions will allow the casts of our PAC productions to deepen their understanding of the world of their particular shows, while getting to connect with other members of the Wolf PAC community.



Wolf Performing Arts Center is a non-profit organization dedicated to enriching the lives of young people through learning, experiencing, and creating theatre. We provide students an opportunity to develop their confidence, character, and creativity in a safe, accepting environment, while deepening the community's appreciation of the performing arts.

## There is something for everyone at Wolf PAC!

### Performances

Performances feature 1st-12th grade students in a variety of musicals and plays during our fall and spring seasons. All performances are directed by theater professionals, enhance theatrical skills through the rehearsal process, and boast a polished, professional-level production at the end of the experience.

#### Theatre Classes

Theatre Classes are offered to preschool-12th grade students during fall, winter, and spring seasons. Taught by professional Teaching Artists, classes include active, engaging, and on-your-feet activities and focus on musical theatre, acting, storytelling, improv and more. At the end of the session, students will come together for a showcase or in class review to share favorite activities and ensemble numbers with an audience.

#### Workshops

Workshops are offered to preschool-12th graders and focus on a variety of themes such as audition technique, ensemble work, social-skill building techniques, writing and more. Art of Auditioning workshops focus on specific monologues, dance and song and are offered before fall and spring auditions.

#### **Summer Theatre Camp**

Throughout our 10-week summer camp season, rising Kindergarten - 12th grade campers and CITs are immersed in theatre programs that focus on making connections, building creativity, and gaining confidence through performance and mentoring opportunities.

#### Private Lessons

Private Lessons are offered to students in grades 1-12 and combine professional teacher expertise with a customized plan of study. Our one-on-one lessons help students gain confidence, reach personal goals, and enhance performance skills. Lessons include voice, acting, dance, beginner piano, audition technique, musical theatre, guitar and ukulele.

#### **Technical Apprentice Program**

Our Technical Apprentice Program (TAP), is for 7th-12th grade students interested in enhancing and learning backstage skills while working side-by-side with top theatre professionals. Students will participate from the beginning of the rehearsal process with opportunities to enhance independence and leadership skills and build resumes for college applications.
