Our Technical Apprenticeship Program allows students interested in **backstage skills** to learn from professional Designers and experienced Directors. Students will participate throughout the rehearsal process, working one-on-one with a mentor to expand their theatrical knowledge while at the same time contributing to the magic of a main stage production.

This fall, we are excited to offer **four** positions to anyone interested in being a part of our **TAP experience**. We have opportunities for those interested in sound design, as well as our tried-and-true Production Assistant positions for our ever-growing onsite programs!

PRODUCTION ASSISTANT

The Production Assistant (PA) will work closely with Directors for an intensive, behind-the-scenes experience designed to support the performers and artistic team. PAs will gain skills in management, leadership, and mentorship as they become an integral member of the production team to help create theater with younger performers.

Responsibilities & Goals:

- To assist artistic team from start of the rehearsal process through performances
- To collaborate with actors and director for a unified vision of the production
- To enhance leadership and mentorship skills
- To research dramaturgically as needed
- To lead small rehearsals in any discipline (choreography, music direction, etc.) as discussed and decided in meetings with director
- To assist with all stage management needs (attendance, blocking, backstage needs, etc.) for rehearsals

SOUND ASSISTANT

The **Sound Assistant (SA)** will work closely with a sound designer for an intensive, behind-the-scenes experience designed to support the performers and artistic team. The SA will gain skills in design and operation, collaboration, mentorship, and join the production team to help create theater with younger performers.

Responsibilities & Goals:

- To assist artistic team from start of the rehearsal process through performances
- To collaborate with sound designer to build a creative soundscape for the performance
- To enhance independence and leadership skills
- To research dramaturgically as needed
- To create a narrative voiceover live for the production
- To assist with all sound design needs (creating and collaborating in rehearsals, making voiceover work, operating the sound board, etc.)
